#### **Lesson Summary**

Students will be introduced to the SNA program, learn about invasive species, learn about specific invasive species that are affecting our local ecosystems, and learn about what they can do to help. Students will watch a short video covering these topics and then be encouraged to complete an invasive species wanted poster highlighting a species of their choice.
